- Academic achievement with a grade point of 2.5 or above
- Applicants seeking scholarship for a trade school / apprenticeship / on-the-job will be judged separately from those seeking scholarships for a four-year degree
- Demonstration that Junior Achievement was instrumental in their educational development
- Ability to succeed in college or career pathway
