- Paper and pencil, scissors
- Bingo markers

Activity

Check off the boxes as you finish your work.

 Using a square piece of paper, create a grid of four squares across and four squares down. Write a job or career you know about in each of the squares. □ Write the title of each career cluster shown below on a separate slip of paper OR write the name of each career cluster on lined paper and cut them apart. Agriculture, Food, & Natural Resources Transportation, Distribution, & Logistics Architecture & Construction Hospitality & Tourism Arts, Audio/Video Technology, & Human Services Communications Information Technology Business, Management, & Law, Public Safety, Corrections, & Administration Security Education & Training Manufacturing Marketing, Sales, & Service Finance Government & Public Administration Science, Technology, Engineering, & Health Science Mathematics Place the career cluster titles in a jar, bowl, or paper bag. Have one player draw out a career cluster title and read it aloud. Find a career on your bingo card that fits into that career cluster. If you are uncertain, discuss it with the other players. Put the career title back in the draw bag. Use small markers, cereal pieces, or other small objects to cover each square as it is called. The

winner is the first one to get a row across, up and down, or diagonal through the center. The real

winner is the one who learns about a new job or career that interests them!
