



Goods and Services

After watching the *JA Ourselves* Lesson 3 volunteer video session, reinforce the learning in the lesson by having your child create coupons for goods or services he could offer at home.

Materials

- 3x5 cards (approximately 10)
- Pen, pencil, and crayons or markers

Activity

On his own or with help from a parent or other caring adult or older sibling, your child should try the following activities:

- Together, make a list of things he knows how to do to help others. These are services. Possibilities include:
 - Sweep the floor.
 - Give a backrub.
 - Put away books and toys.
- Make another list of things he could make for others. These are goods. Possibilities include:
 - Friendship bracelet
 - Peanut butter and jelly sandwich
 - Sock puppet
- Have your child create coupons offering his goods and services.
 - Use small pieces of paper or 3 x 5 cards.
 - Write the good or service in the center.
 - Decorate the border or draw a picture of the good or service.
- Help him decide if he will offer his goods and services for free, or if he will ask for money. He can:
 - Write FREE on the coupon, OR
 - Write how much money he wants to earn from the sale of each good or service.

When the coupons have been created, your child can offer them to close friends and family members. Consider allowing him to use the phone or Internet to contact relatives and offer his coupons. The coupons can be sent by mail and redeemed at a later date.
