



Entrepreneurs Go Global

After watching the *JA Our Region* Lesson 5 volunteer video session, complete the following activity.

Materials

- World map
- Markers
- Small stickers (optional)

Activity

- Look for the maker mark of five different things in your room or home. These could be clothes, packaged food, or other useful items. Discover where these products are made. You can locate the mark on the bottom, on the label, or on the tag.
- Find the locations on a world map, and then use a marker or a small sticker to tag each spot.
- Research one item to find out where and how it is made. This will work best if you choose something with many parts, such as a phone, radio, computer, or even a pencil! Make a list of the parts and where they are manufactured.
- Find the locations on the world map, and mark them with a different sticker or colored marker.
- If you want, connect the dots with string or draw lines on the map from one location to another.
- Draw some conclusions:
 - Do some countries produce more things than others?
 - Do some types of items or resources come from one general area?
 - Can you predict what might happen if a natural disaster hit that part of the world and they could not deliver their products?
- Write a paragraph describing the product and its supply chain:
 - First, state what your product is.
 - Next, tell what its parts are.
 - Then, explain where each part is made.
 - Finally, explain how you think that chain might change and why.
